

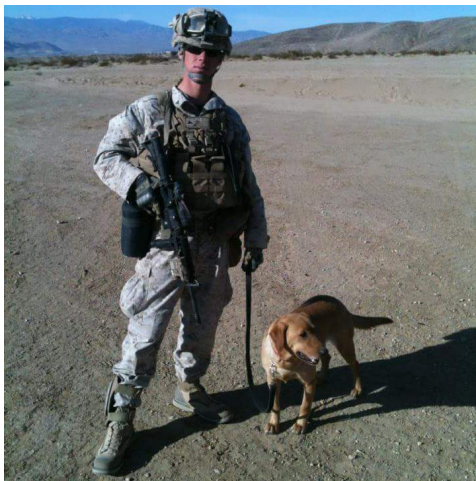
Springfield 1911 Stainless Raffle
