
Retired CPL Joshua Sust

Joshua Sust was born on January 20, 1987 in Cincinnati, Ohio. He graduated from Colerain High School in June of 2006. 2 weeks after his graduation he was on a bus to the Parris Island Marine Corps Recruit Depot. After 13 grueling weeks, he accomplished his greatest achievement becoming a United States Marine. Upon completion of boot camp PVT. Sust was headed to the School Of Infantry East at Camp Gieger, NC. After another grueling 3 months, PFC Sust graduated SOI and was headed to the Fleet Marine Force with 2nd Battalion 4th Marines at Camp Pendleton, CA. CPL. Sust spent a total of 7 years with the 2/4 and had 3 deployments with them. His first two were the 31st and 11th Marine Expeditionary Units and on his last and final deployment CPL. Sust was deployed to Helmand Provence, Afghanistan in September of 2011.

CPL. Josh Sust's Alive Day, on November 12th, 2011 at around 0830, CPL. Sust was on a mounted patrol when his Vehicle hit an I.E.D., causing his door to be blown off and he was ejected. His injuries included Traumatic Brain Injury, Post-traumatic stress disorder, shattered tibia and fibula, left foot (Limb salvage) and open fractures to both bones in his left arm.

After years of therapy and 9 surgeries later CPL. Sust was medically retired from the Marine Corps in August of 2013. In August of 2015, Josh made the decision along with his care team to do a below knee amputation. This decision has changed his life for the better. He is no longer in pain and off all pain medication.

In 2016 Josh began a new carrier in the prosthetics field as a technician and patient adviser. It was an act of selfless service, helping new amputees continue on with their lives, telling them it's not the end, it's just a new beginning. He truly believes that mindset. In spring of 2023, Josh decided to retire once again. Josh enjoys his time giving back to the organizations that helped him out during his difficult times. He enjoys being outside hunting and fishing. Josh likes to get other warriors to participate in Outdoor Healing & Therapeutic Adventures. He enjoys spending time with family, friends, and his good dog Loki.


